As well as the normal watercolour on our list of materials also bring along a tube of White Gouache and Yellow Ochre Gouache

Medium: Watercolour

Theme: Subjects from the garden and surrounding parts of the estate – This will allow us the opportunity to use the strong vibrant colours that watercolour gives us.

This course will cover some aspects of colour mixing and the other elements to be considered when trying to achieve colour interaction. Use transparent dark areas to animate the delicate light colours.

We will be painting in the very beautiful top floor rooms of Belvedere House. The views from these rooms across the lake and parklands are inspirational.
